#### **Executive Summary**



In Q2 2023, we made significant strides in our reforestation mission, planting 32,5 million trees since inception. Financially, we generated €850,991, with a -22% decrease compared to Q2 2022 globally, but remarkable 143% growth in our B2B self-service segment. B2C TN's community revenue showed a 6% increase over Q2 2022. We affiliated with four new projects, conducted 11 project verification visits, and made strategic hires, including a Head of IT and two project managers. Technological advancements included site transition and the launch of the platform map project. Our communication efforts focused on campaign restructuring, social media growth, mapping emails, and Chatbot AI FSM for customer support. Internally, we improved B2B database segmentation, initiated the outbound project, and refined project management practices. Despite the world economic recession, we remain committed to investing in our projects and improving productivity.




#### **Agroforestry Systems, Mexico**

#### Bosques de Agua, Argentina

Bosques de Agua works in the reforestation of native highland forests, which play a vital role in the water cycle. The native tree that grows at these heights is the *Tabaquillo* (Polylepis australis). They are the ones that allow the mountain to become a great reservoir of water. From here their purpose was born: To cover the mountains with forests again! They are producing and planting 300.000 *tabaquillos* this 2023 and we aim to scale up to 500.000 next year 2024.

### Revitalizing Coastal Marsh Ecosystems through Mangrove Reforestation!

#### **EDEN Reforestation Project, Madagascar**

In April 2023, the Tree-Nation Reforestation Project team visited our local partner, Eden Madagascar for an annual onsite verification. Over the course of 2 days, John Bett (Tree-Nation Regional Manager for Africa) and Hugo Bitouzé (Tree-nation Head of Reforestation Projects) were on the ground, deep in the mangrove forest measuring trees, interviewing local communities alongside Eden local team. The primary aim of our visit was to assess the ongoing progress of the project, its effect on mangrove forest restoration, and the engagement with the local communities of Madagascar. Our journey led us to their planting site in Ankinao, where we witnessed good advancements, which will be elaborated in the forthcoming report
